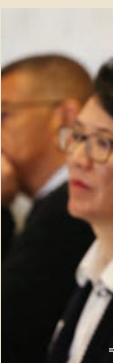

Experiencing timeless wisdom

My first encounter with the Trinity Forum was in the aftermath of a workaholic crash. I'd had two stressful, highly demanding jobs and had completely lost touch with my wife and three young daughters—and with God. I realized that I didn't know how to pray, didn't know how to read the Bible, and wasn't convinced that God was in charge and Jesus was who He said He was.

The encounter was a turning point. The discussion and *Trinity Forum Readings* on the theme, "A Thinking Leader's Quest for Meaning," were just what I needed to get out of my workaholic haze. We had a wonderfully diverse and thought-provoking group of participants. It was actually the tipping point for a two-year journey from being a "social Christian" to becoming a true believer. It was a journey that included regular meetings with our pastor, a series of breakfast conversations over *Readings* with international community colleagues, an occasional Trinity Forum gathering, and (once I learned how) lots of prayer.

Decades after my first epiphany, *Trinity Forum Readings*, podcasts, and events continue to renew my faith and provide rich materials for my engagement with the younger generation.
